

The Olivia Rogers Scholarships

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

1. What will The Olivia Rogers Scholarships support?

The Olivia Rogers Scholarships will support regional netballers to take the court at a time when they may not have been able to necessarily afford to do so due to suffering some form of adversity in their lives.

2. How will funds be distributed?

The funds will be directly deposited to the successful Applicants/Nominees nominated bank account.

3. How can I utilise these funds?

Part of the awarded funds must be used to register or as reimbursement for a Grafton Netball Association (GNA) registration fee. Some ideas on how the Scholarship funds can be used include netball uniforms, netball shoes, costs associated with participating in the representative season, petrol to get to netball games, etc.

All receipts must be presented with the Acquittal Report.

4. Who can apply for The Olivia Rogers Scholarships?

All netball players registered or intending on registering with GNA, and may be struggling with the cost of the upcoming netball season due to suffering some form of adversity in their lives in the last 12 months.

5. When will the Application process close?

Applications/Nominations for The Olivia Rogers Scholarships will close on 31st March*

**The date may be changed or altered at the discretion of The Day For Liv Committee. Refer to Terms & Conditions for more information.*

6. What if I have already paid my GNA registration fees?

If you have already paid GNA registration fees for the current season and you are a successful Scholarship Recipient of an Olivia Rogers Scholarship, part of the funds will be seen as a reimbursement of your registration fees.

7. How many Scholarships are available?

There are four (4) Scholarships available. Each one has a value of \$500.



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8. What if my Application/Nomination is successful?

If you are successful, you will receive a phone call followed by a confirmation email.

The Scholarship must be used for the costs associated with netball. The successful Applicants/Nominees must use the Scholarship proceeds to register with GNA.

Payments will be made via direct deposit. Once notified, the successful Applicants/Nominees must supply their bank details to The Day For Liv Treasurer.

The Scholarship is to be fully expended within the current netball season in which it is awarded.

An Acquittal Report of how the Scholarship money was spent and how it was beneficial to you will need to be provided to The Day For Liv Committee before July. An Acquittal Report template will be provided to you to complete.

9. Will there be feedback for unsuccessful Applications/Nominations?

The Scholarship program is run by a small number of volunteers. Due to the number of Applications/Nominations received, unfortunately, it is not possible to provide formal feedback on unsuccessful applications.

10. Who will make the decision on whether my Application/Nomination is successful or not?

There will be an Adjudication Panel of three people including:

- A GNA Representative (not affiliated with any Club);
- A Community Member (not affiliated with any Club); and
- A family representative.

11. Where does the funding for the Scholarships come from?

The funding is being provided by the Confident Girls Foundation on an annual basis. This endeavour is proudly supported by GNA, and The Day For Liv Committee.
