All involved believe that this is the perfect way to celebrate and remember a young girl who loved netball so passionately. The Scholarships will go towards supporting regional netballers that are experiencing adversity or hardship in their life.

We want to bring rainbows to the game that Olivia loved so much and to netballers that have shown the courage, strength, and never give up attitude that Olivia showed throughout her battle with sarcoma.

The Olivia Rogers Scholarships will be awarded to players who, without this assistance, would not have been able to take the netball court and play netball. The Scholarships are \$500 for each player and four (4) players will be chosen.

Purpose:

To give back to the Grafton netball community by financially assisting regional netball players who love netball and work hard to improve each season but may be battling to play this season due to an adverse event that has occurred recently in their life.





The Olivia Rogers Scholarships

1. Eligibility Criteria

- The Applicant/Nominee will have been impacted directly or indirectly by hardship/adversity in the last 12 months;
- The hardship/adversity can be anything (examples include but are not limited to loss of job, medical episode, drought, loss of a loved one, marriage/family breakdown, etc) but must have led to financial hardship;
- The Applicant/Nominee must use part of the awarded funds to register with any affiliated Club of Grafton Netball Association (GNA);
- The player can apply, or a person over the age of 18 (parent, guardian, executive, friend) can nominate a player on their behalf;
- The Applicant/Nominee can be from any Club affiliated with GNA and can play at any level of netball;
- The Applicant/Nominee can be any age; and
- One (1) Scholarship per family is available.
